## Buffalo Lake Restocking Begins

The Buffalo Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District began restocking fish into Buffalo Lake from Montello to Packwaukee on Monday of this week. Several volunteers distributed 50 gallons of minnows, 10,000 panfish and 200 bass as the start of the restocking process, which was described as, "a drop in the bucket." The project was launched as a result of the multi-year drawdown that was done during reconstruction and repair of the dredge bank road and dam area in Montello. The entire restocking process could last until 2017.

The next step will be a survey by the DNR in the spring of 2015. At that time they will determine how many and what type of game fish need to be stocked. The district expects to stock in both the spring and the fall.

Many individuals and businesses have donated to the restocking program, in addition to fundraisers and collection cans placed throughout the community. The district will put cans back out in the spring and be holding additional fundraisers.
